Who We Are

The Annual West Seattle Garden Tour started as a fundraiser for ArtsWest in 1994. The tour takes place each July and features residential and public gardens in West Seattle. Today the WSGT is a 503c non-profit organization. In addition to benefiting ArtsWest, the tour also chooses a select number of additional organizations as beneficiaries.

Beneficiary Criteria

The West Seattle Garden Tour seeks to support horticultural/environmental projects and organizations that serve the public by providing education, or creating and improving public spaces.

Grant Information

The amount the grants is based on the profits from the tour each year. Grants are presented in August.

Presentation Guidelines

To be considered as a Beneficiary, you must make a short presentation no longer than 10 - 15 minutes about your project and organization to committee members during one of our monthly meetings.

*Presentations generally take place from October through January.

*It is helpful to provide a handout for committee members.

Information to include in your presentation

*Specifically, what will you use the money for?

*Do you have any sources for matching funds?

*Would you or a member of your organization be willing to staff a table in one of the gardens on the day of the tour with information about your project and organization?
